- CLASS 1: EDRC Walk Trot Test A** - Horse/rider combinations not to have won any dressage test including Walk Trot tests. Test attached.
- CLASS 2: Preliminary 4 (2002)** - Horse & Rider combinations not to have won 3 firsts at Restricted Prelim level or above.
- CLASS 3: Preliminary 12 (2005)** - Open - **RoR Qualifier – see Rule 17**
- CLASS 4: Novice 20 (2007)** - Horse & Rider combinations not to have won 3 firsts at Restricted Novice level or above.
- CLASS 5: Novice 28 (2008)** - Open - **RoR Qualifier – see Rule 17**
- CLASS 6: Elementary 45 (2010)** - Open.

PLEASE NOTE - The Walk Trot test WILL BE LIMITED to the first 15 entries received. Other classes may be limited to ensure completion of the show at a reasonable time.

Rules

1. All horses to be age 4yrs and over and all riders to be aged 16 years or over.
2. Horses may not be entered in more than 3 classes.
3. Horses entered in class 6 may not enter classes 1, 2 or 3.
4. Strictly no dogs.
5. This competition is run under British Riding Club Rules.
6. Under BRC rules a hard hat to EN1384, PAS015, prefixed ASTM or SEI must be worn and fastened at all times while mounted. American standard SNELL E2001 SNZ 3838 (Australasia) also allowed. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified.
7. Neither the organisers of this event, nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the showground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
8. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
9. EDRC members will receive league table points in all classes. **Memberships must be fully paid up to qualify for points – please note club membership renewal date of 1 October 2012.**
10. The judge's decision is final. Any complaints must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by £20 and the complaint must be made within one hour of the incident.
11. Entry fees only refunded if the show is cancelled, classes are full, or if you cannot compete after the entry but agree to help at the show if this is required. An administration fee may be taken from each competitor.
12. Riding Club rules for area competitions apply, dressage tests may be read.
13. Cantering is allowed only in practice and competition areas.
14. The organisers reserve the right to combine or split classes according to entries with results determined on a percentage basis.
15. **There will be a limited number of entries available in each class.**
16. *******PLEASE NOTE, use of this venue is subject to certain terms, one of which is that the venue, including the parking area, must be left clean & tidy. As a result, ANY ENTRANTS NOT LEAVING THE PARKING AREAS AS THEY FOUND THEM WILL NOT HAVE FUTURE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. PLEASE THEREFORE ENSURE YOU REMOVE ALL HAY/DROPPINGS/LITTER ETC.*******
17. UNAFFILIATED **ROR DRESSAGE QUALIFYING ROUNDS - WINTER 2012** - Open to registered ROR and non-registered ex- racehorses but on qualifying non- registered horses must register with the ROR (Retraining of Racehorses) which can be done on-line and is free. www.ror.org.uk in Preliminary and Novice qualifying classes with a minimum mark of 60%. Qualifying rosettes to third place. The Final, date and place to be confirmed. ROR will provide qualifying rosettes for each round. At the Final, rosettes will go to sixth place plus the winner will receive a prize in kind. Special award to the highest placed veteran horse (over 15 years old).
